This funding will be used to

- Improve the percentage of Year 3 students meeting the National Minimum Standards in Reading to 96% in 2019 NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands for Reading to 55% in 2019 NAPLAN.
- Improve the percentage of Year 3 students meeting the National Minimum Standards in Writing to 89% in 2019 NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands for Writing to 25% in 2019 NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of Year 5 students meeting National Minimum Standards in Writing to 85% in 2019 NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of Year 5 students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands for Writing to 12% in 2019 NAPLAN.
- Support each student at risk of not achieving the National Minimum Standards in Reading and Writing (as reflected in internal school data) with tailored support programs in Years Prep – 3.

Our initiatives include


- Implementing a consistent, whole school approach to the teaching of Writing.
- Implementation of a school wide approach to the teaching of Spelling.
- Student goal setting in the areas of Reading and Writing.
- Providing additional Speech Language intervention for identified students.
- Professional development opportunities through the Reading Hub.
- Upskilling of teacher aides in the areas of Reading and Writing.
- Collecting regular and accurate data on students to target resources and tailor programs for individuals and small groups.
- Support for at risk students through case management practices.
- Provide support and resources towards Early Years Literacy Programs.
