Ipswich North State School will receive**

\$147,710

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of all students attaining a C standard or higher in English to 85% in 2020.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving the National Minimum Standards in NAPLAN Reading to 94%.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN Reading to 35%.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving in the Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN Numeracy to 20%.

Our initiatives include

- Improving the whole staff understanding and knowledge of the Australian Curriculum standards.
- Implement planning cycles with classroom and specialist teachers who are released from class to work collaboratively with the HOC every 5 weeks.
- Provide in house professional development and coaching on the INSS Pedagogical Framework for teachers and teacher aides to deepen the understanding of effective teaching practices.
- Further develop teacher capability to implement a student centred curriculum aligned to short term data cycles and student goal setting.
- Develop a shared understanding of data literacy and support staff to effectively use data to inform, plan and implement targeted teaching.
- Provide increased access to digital equipment to develop the ICT general capabilities of students.
