OWNERSHIP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • speak proactively 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • informing staff if the behaviour of others is negatively impacting them or their family • taking responsibility for their child arriving and departing school safely on time every day

COOPERATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • stay current with school information 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • stay informed about school news/activities by reading school newsletter, other written communication and school social media
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • use the school’s communication process to address concerns 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • respecting staff time by accepting they will respond to appropriate communication when they are able • requesting a meeting to discuss any concerns about their child’s education – allowing staff time to prepare and appreciating their time may be limited
